PETITION TO IOC

At this time we know that over 70,000 signatures have been sent in support of our recognition by the IOC. The ITF appreciates the hard work of all members who supported and collected signatures for the petition and we give you thanks for not letting us appear without support.

At this time we have still not had any notification from some countries and are rather dismayed by the lack of effort to ensure that we may fully represent our efforts. This pre-supposes that some countries have been been slow in letting us have their figures and we shudder to think that it could be because some of you have not bothered. When we feel that we have all the figures then we will print a further letter in detail and we urge those of you who have not done so to let us have your figures.

PROGRAMME OF EVENTS 1987

In previous letters we have asked you to let us know your programme for International and National events so that we may make a calendar and to assist in avoiding a clash of dates. Please be kind enough to let us have a programme of all your events for 1987. This should include all competitions, courses, seminars and promotion tests. It would be good to see a comprehensive programme of all events and would be most impressive in chart form. Do your best for us, it will be published for all to see.

WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS IN MALAYSIA

The rules for the championships were sent out and you should have received them by this time. We regret that a couple of items were in error in that the ladies weight divisions were omitted and the female Power Test included palkup.

Page 2, Article 7.(3)(b) should read: Female - Sonkal, Balkal. Page 2, Article 8.(b) should read: The individual match sparring events are divided into Group 'A' (1st. and 2nd. Degree) and Group 'B' (3rd. and 4th. Degree).

These are further divided into:

MALE

i) Lightweight - up to 63 kg.

ii) Middleweight - over 63 & up to 74 kg.

iii) Heavyweight - over 74 kg.

FEMALE

i) Lightweight - up to 55 kg.

ii) Middleweight - over 55 & up to 62 kg.

iii) Heavyweight - over 62 kg.

Please correct your copies to read as above.

PLease also find enclosed pictures and instructions with regard to the hand signals and terminology to be used during the match. Our thanks to Master Han Sam Soo, Chairman of the Umpire Committee, for his excellent endeavours in producing these.

DEGREE CERTIFICATES

Why it is so difficult for people to understand this we do not know, perhaps we do not explain it simply enough?! so here we go again. Please fill in all the details which are asked for. Name should be written as your surname and then your forename. Nationality is for only one entry and not Spanish/American or Chinese/Malaysian etc. Date of birth should have the month written first and not as a figure like 3 but written March then the date and then the year. We require three(3)THREE photographs with the application, two(2)TWO should be of normal passport size and one(1)ONE should be no bigger than 3 centimetres x 2 centimetres. The DATE is for the date of the test(grading)EXAMINATION by the examiner. It must be signed by the Instructor and we would prefer to also have the instructor's name printed. It must also be signed by the President of the National Governing Body unless he has given permission for someone else to sign it and we would require a letter to say that someone else may sign it and this letter would have to be signed by the President.
